



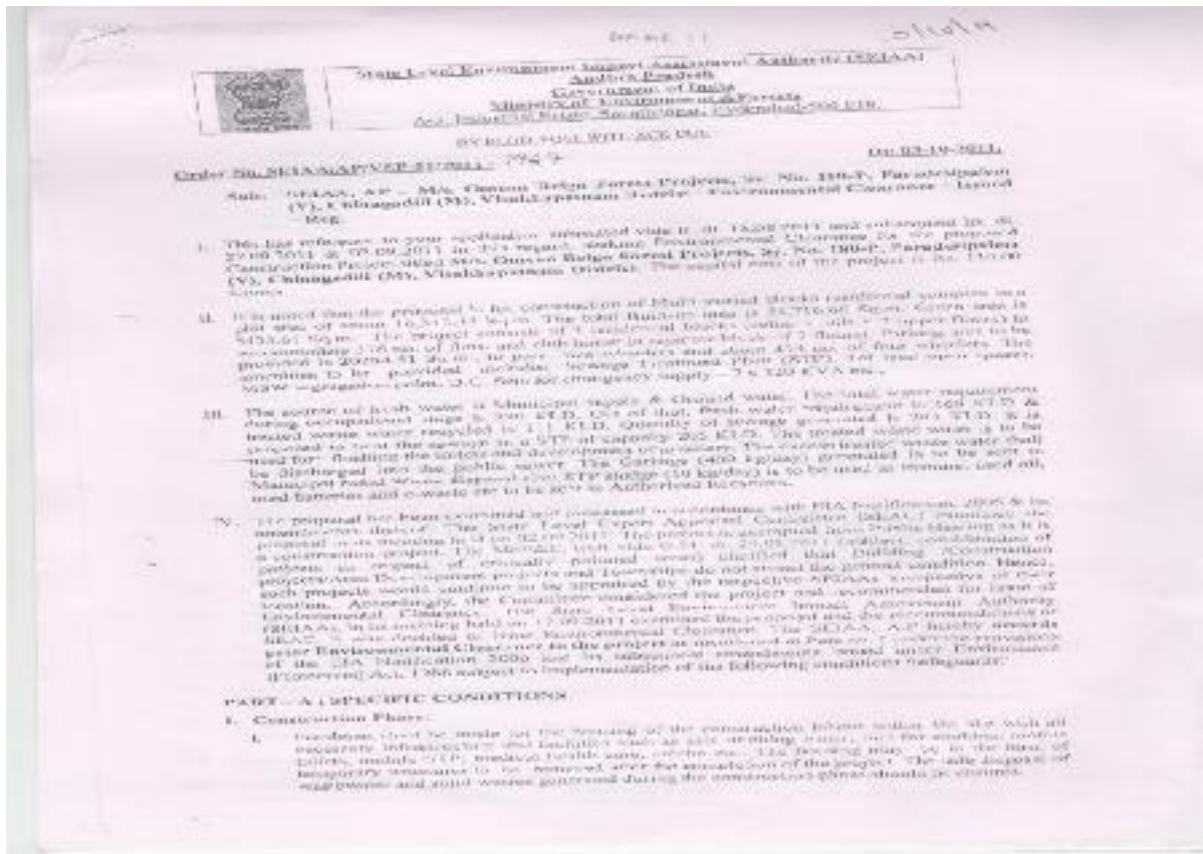

The overflow from this tank is taken to filter feed sump from where it is pumped through the Dual Media filter for final treatment and the treated water is re-used as feed water for washing, gardening & floor washings purposes.
